Category Description and Guidelines

Students are invited to enter their original cartoons or comic strips in a Native American language. This category encourages students to combine art, storytelling, humor and literacy skills. While the form may be modern, finding humor in everyday situations, telling humorous stories and illustrating daily life are traditional art forms. *Comic books or graphic novels (multiple pages) will not be accepted for the 2021 ONAYLF.*

- ✗ Use food, animals or organic materials (grass, bark, leaves) on your hardcopy
- ✗ Plagiarize. Work must be original.

● Entries that include copyrighted characters (such as Marvel, Disney, etc.) will be disqualified. We cannot judge or display these submissions. Avoid copyright infringement.

Submission of Your Entry

We must receive all submissions on or before the deadline posted on the website. All entries should be submitted in digital form: .pdf or .jpg format. Entries may be e-mailed to ONAYLF or posted in the ONAYLF Dropbox. Follow the instructions on the ONAYLF Webpage. A Material Submission form should be sent with each entry: add it as the second sheet to the comic.

Judging Comics & Cartoons Submissions

Material submissions are judged electronically. Please have the student(s) complete the Material Submission form (below) to explain more about the comic and its personal significance for the author(s). A panel of at least three elders, Native language teachers and/or Native authors/artists will judge comics and cartoons on these criteria:

- Amount of Native language used
- Creativity in illustrations
- Use of complete sentences
- Effort in presentation

- You must pre-register to receive awards. Please do so as early as possible.
- Make sure you keep a copy of your comic just in case there are problems with delivery.
