A Night with Bats



Under the Arctic: Digging into Permafrost was produced and is toured by the Oregon Museum of Science and Industry. The exhibit was developed in collaboration with the Geophysical Institute at the University of Alaska Fairbanks and made possible by a National Science Foundation (NSF) grant.

Half-day camps run Monday through Friday. Cost is \$175 for members, \$225 for non-members. Extended drop-off is available at 7:30 a.m. for an additional \$50 per week.

Each day will feature different activities both inside and outside the museum. Campers are required to bring a lunch and two snacks for each day of camp.

Join us in the Discovery Room for programs geared toward preschool and elementary-aged children. Each week we will explore a different natural history topic through stories, crafts and museum specimens.




