

SAM NOBLE OKLAHOMA MUSEUM OF NATURAL HISTORY SAMPLING AGREEMENT

1. The choice of specimens/objects will be determined and approved by the appropriate Curator(s). Sampling should involve the smallest possible amount of material, so that the potential for compromising the future utility of the specimen/object is minimized.
2. The Sam Noble Oklahoma Museum of Natural History (SNOMNH) retains the right to insist that sampling is done in the appropriate laboratory within the SNOMNH. The SNOMNH undertakes not to publicize any new technique arising from such work until such innovations have been published.
3. The applicant agrees to return to the SNOMNH all unused portions of specimens/objects, molecular extracts, ancillary products, and/or analytical results (including raw data, if applicable), unless otherwise agreed upon.
4. The applicant agrees to provide resulting data to a public archive (e.g., GenBank), if applicable, indicating the SNOMNH catalog numbers, and provide such archival numbers to the SNOMNH no later than the time of submission of some or all of the data for publication. The SNOMNH agrees not to disseminate any such data until they have been accepted for publication.
5. The applicant will provide copies of proposed methods or experimental protocols when these differ from published methods.
6. The applicant will provide copies of all required permits if applicable.
7. The applicant will properly acknowledge the SNOMNH and its collections in all presentations and publications containing data derived from SNOMNH specimens/objects as follows: _____

8. The applicant will supply reprints of any published work containing data derived from SNOMNH specimens or objects.
9. When appropriate, research proposals that involve the use of specimens/objects from the SNOMNH collections must include a request for funds to help the SNOMNH provide the necessary resources.
10. The SNOMNH retains all "rights" to the material derived from specimens/objects in its collections. All requests, for example to pass material to third parties, should be addressed to the Curator(s) of the appropriate department.
11. The applicant agrees to pay the SNOMNH a fee of \$ _____ unless charges are waived ().
