Category Description and Guidelines

Students perform a short mobile video suitable for sharing on TikTok® or Instagram® in a Native language. The mobile video is recorded on a mobile phone and submitted electronically. Presentations promote fluency, confidence, fun and creative expression in Native language use. The mobile video must incorporate the use of spoken Native language; use of written language is encouraged. Videos submitted in this category are not eligible for the Film and Video performance category and are not screened at the Fair. The short video **must** include spoken Native Language.

• Spoken Language: Mobile Video entries are **video-recorded** and the recording is submitted.

- ✓ Keep a 30-second to 3-minute time limit
- ✓ Use props, costumes and Native regalia
- ✓ Video-record the performance and submit the video-recording to ONAYLF

Judging Performances

A panel of at least three elders, Native language teachers and/or Native speakers will judge performances on these criteria:

- Amount of Native American language used
- Presentation and poise of performance
- Appropriateness to the mobile video genre
- Ease and comfort of language use
- Spirit and creativity of performance

Submission of Performance

We must receive all submissions on or before the deadline posted on the website for judging. You can email or upload your video-recorded entry in the ONAYLF Dropbox or Google Drive folders. Follow the instructions on the ONAYLF website. Complete and submit a Submission Form for each Spoken Language Mobile Video Performance entered. Label your video: "Performer_Name_Program_Name_GradeLevel".

- You must pre-register to be judged and to receive awards. Please do so as early as possible.
